






Sunset in Jurmala






Nightly adventure - trip in Riga channel and Daugava river

There is no previous experience needed, instructions and a pro guide is with you at all times.




Visit the Science Centre AHHAA (Tartu, Estonia, bus tour)

The AHHAA Science Centre offers science, excitement, adventure, and fun for everyone. This centre is an attractive learning environment in which you are bound to learn something new.






Location
